- 3. If sufficient number of candidates are not available to fill up the seats reserved for SCs they shall be filled up by suitable candidates from STs and vice versa. If both SC & ST candidates are not available to fill the seats, they may be filled up by general category candidates.

## **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

The candidates have to attend the certificate verification in person along with the following original certificates and two sets of xerox copies.

- 1. Entrance Test Hall Ticket: 2024.
- 2. Secondary School Certificate (S.S.C.), Intermediate Memo, Degree certificate, **PG (M.A. / M.Sc. Psychology)** certificate (or provisional certificate if the degree is not yet issued as per rules) of the qualifying examination.
- 3. Consolidated Memorandum of Marks of the qualifying examination.
- 4. Transfer Certificate (T.C).
- 5. Proof of Local/Non-Local candidates, according to rules in force. Those who have studied Degree and P.G. courses as regular students need to submit the bonafide certificates from colleges where they have studied the said courses. If the candidate did not enrol his/her name in any college/institute/University and/or elsewhere as a regular student, he/she has to submit gap certificate issued by MRO.
- 6. Community, Nativity and Date of Birth Certificate for SC., ST., BC., EWS., candidates as per the guidelines of Social Welfare, Telangana.

#### Notes:

- 1. The candidates, who fail to submit the certificates in original or fail to pay the fee on the spot, will not be considered for admission. Fee once paid, will not be refunded.
- 2. If any candidate fails to attend the certificate verification as per the given schedule when he/she is called for admission, he/she forfeits the claim for admission to the course.
- 3. The genuineness or otherwise of the social status claim of the candidates seeking admission under SC/ST/BC categories shall be verified by the Director of Social Welfare/ Director of Tribal Welfare /Director of Backward Classes of Government of Telangana., respectively, whose decision in this regards will be final. The admissions to the seats reserved for SC/ST/BC shall be deemed provisional till the genuineness of the social status of the candidates is verified by the respective authorities cited above.
- 4. The admission of a candidate will be cancelled at any time during the course of study and the candidate is liable for criminal prosecution, if it is found that admission is secured on false grounds or by suppression of facts.
